



SUBJECT: **WORKSHOP WITH VILLAGE BUSINESS
AND PROPERTY OWNERS**

BACKGROUND:

With springtime upon us, City Council needs to give direction regarding the planting of flowers in the Village this year. Also, now that the Wayfinding Sign Program design phase is complete, City Council should give direction regarding replacement of the overhead sign that was knocked down by a City dump truck.

In order to have a discussion with the Village owners on these issues, I scheduled a workshop meeting for 6:30 p.m. in Hofert Hall on Wednesday, April 21, 2004. I sent the enclosed memorandum to the business and property owners within the Village Assessment District asking them to attend or send their comments to me ahead of the workshop. To date I have not received any comments.

I stated in the memo to the owners, that at the workshop the following will be discussed:

1. Replacement of the overhead sign.
2. Possibly canceling the planting of flowers due to water and restrictions.
3. Other issues affecting the Village.

I would recommend that Council conduct the discussion in the above order and attempt to get closure on the first two items before proceeding to the third.

RECOMMENDATION:

- 1) Receive a staff presentation regarding the replacement of the overhead sign.
- 2) Discussion/direction to staff.
- 3) Receive a staff presentation regarding the planting of flowers in the Village.
- 4) Discussion/direction to staff.
- 5) Discussion/direction to staff regarding other issues affecting the Village.
