City Council Appoints New Mayor for 2006

BIG BEAR LAKE, CA – At their regular meeting on December 12, Big Bear Lake City Council unanimously selected Bill Jahn as Mayor and Shed Conklin as Mayor Pro Tem for 2006, effective immediately. In addition, Liz Harris was appointed as Chairman of the Improvement Agency and Bill Jahn as Vice-Chair. Harris and Jahn will also serve as Chair and Vice-Chair of the Finance Authority, respectively. That assignment will take effect January 1, 2006. Recalling his time served over the past year, out-going Mayor Darrell Mulvihill stated, "Thank you to my counterparts on the Council, city staff and the community for your dedication and support. Serving in this role has truly been a rewarding experience."

During the meeting, City Manager Michael Perry asked that all council members complete their requests for 2006 committee assignments so that official appointments can take place at the next Council meeting on January 9, 2006.

The City of Big Bear Lake is a four-season resort located in the heart of the San Bernardino National Forest, approximately 30 miles northeast of San Bernardino. The City serves a population of 6,500 residents and covers a 6.95 square mile area on the west end of Big Bear Lake's south shore. Recreation is offered year-round, including skiing, boating, fishing, camping, hiking, golf and fine dining.
