NOTICE OF ELECTION**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a General Municipal Election will be held in the City of Big Bear Lake, California on Tuesday, November 8, 2022 for the following officers and Measures:

Three (3) Members of the City Council – District 2, District 3 & District 4  
(Full Terms of Four Years)

"Shall a measure be adopted to amend the Big Bear Lake Municipal Code to limit the number of vacation rental licenses the City may issue to a maximum of 1,500 and limit the number of vacation rental contracts to 30 per year per property, excluding home-sharing arrangements, limiting duplexes, triplexes and four-plexes to one vacation rental per property, and enacting additional further limitations and regulations for vacation rentals?"	<b>YES</b>

"Shall a measure be adopted to increase the maximum rate of the City’s Transient Occupancy (Hotel) Tax charged to hotel and vacation rental guests from 8% to 9% as of January 1, 2024 and from 9% to 10% , as of January 1, 2025, providing until ended by voters an estimated \$1,300,000 annually for City services including public safety response, street repair and maintenance, park and trail construction and maintenance and for general government use?"	<b>YES</b>

The nomination period for these offices will be from July 18, 2022 and close on August 12, 2022 at 5:00 p.m.

If nomination papers for an incumbent officer of the city are not filled by Friday, August 12, 2022 (the 88<sup>th</sup> day before the election), the voters shall have until the 83<sup>rd</sup> day, Wednesday, August 17, 2020, by 5:00 p.m. to nominate candidates other than the person(s) who are the incumbents on the 88<sup>th</sup> day before the election, for that incumbent’s elective office.

If no one or only one person is nominated for an elective office, appointment to the elective office may be made as prescribed by Section 10229, Elections Code of the State of California.

The vote center locations and hours of operations, ballot drop box locations and hours of operations, vote-by-mail procedures and timing, the election officers, and all other persons and procedures for the General Municipal Election shall be the same as those utilized by the County of San Bernardino and in compliance with the Elections Code of the State of California. On election day, the polls will be open between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.
